

MIPS 2023

This document is intended to highlight the primary differences between how providers have completed MIPS previously with WebPT EMR and how MIPS will be documented in Keet moving forward.

SETUP

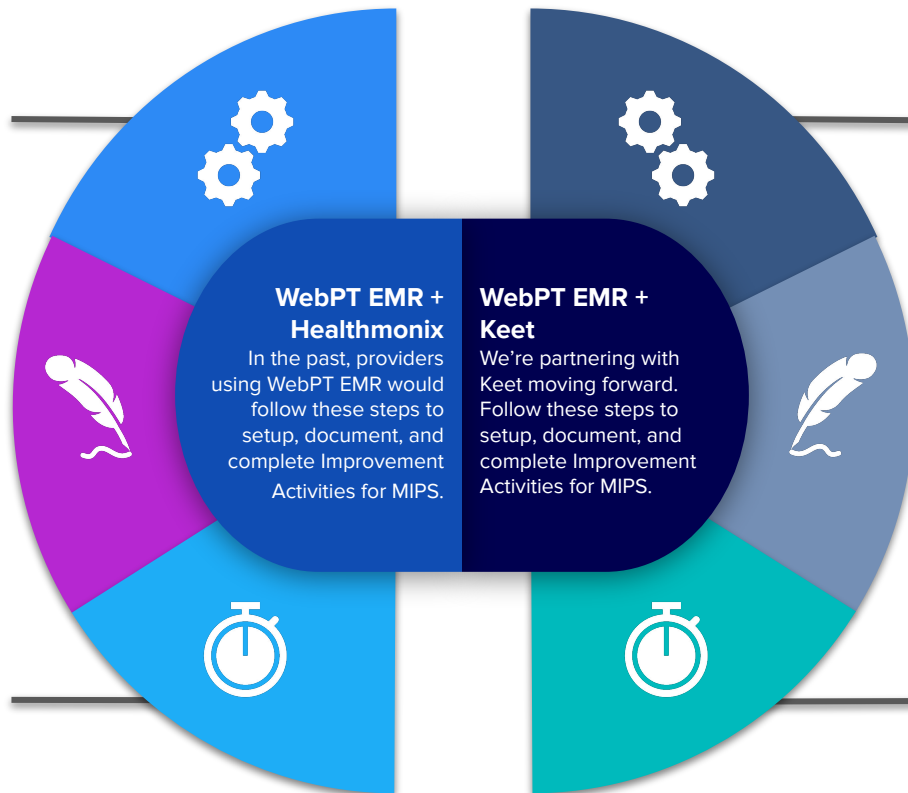
- Complete setup manually for Healthmonix portal
- Complete the WebPT EMR Setup – choose your reporting method, select which measures to collect data for, and verify your EIN

DOCUMENTATION

- Providers document notes entirely within WebPT EMR
- Supporting documentation occurred in the MIPS Data collection Fields on Subjective & Objective tab - Process Measures and PROs input here and they were mandatory before finalizing a note.
 - Previously providers could send patients Patient Reported Outcome Measures (PROs) ahead of time and pull the score into the documentation
- The key requirements for MIPS submission were input in MIPS tab in Soap 1.0 and the MIPS drawer in 2.0 - where they indicated if they have met the measure
- Data goes into Healthmonix with weekly updates
- Data submitted from Healthmonix to CMS
- Measures required were dependent on CPT codes and ICD-10 (Diagnosis codes)

IMPROVEMENT ACTIVITIES

- Previously, providers would submit Improvement Activities directly through Healthmonix



SETUP

- Complete setup in the Keet Portal – clinic admin invites Providers to Keet
- The WebPT EMR setup is the same, but you won't have to choose which measures to report on - they're all available!

DOCUMENTATION

WebPT EMR experience will be the same

- Supporting documentation will occur in the WebPT EMR, but key requirements will be completed in Keet for MIPS submission
- MIPS indicator badges will still appear next to supporting fields for Process Measures on the Subjective & Objective tab, but they won't block you from finalizing a note
- Automate PRO delivery after logging in to Keet and activating your Automated Workflows. Then, simply add the test and input the score in the Objective Tab.
- Will not need to bill any CPT codes for MIPS reporting | Reporting will not prevent providers from completing a note

Accessing Keet

- Click on the MIPS button on the patient chart - links provider to the Keet Login Page in a new browser tab. If logged in within past 3 hours, the patient's chart in Keet will populate
- The MIPS Tab/Drawer now appears before billing tab

IMPROVEMENT ACTIVITIES

- Providers will log into app.cms.gov to attest to their annual Improvement Activities directly to CMS
